Team Composition: School, Community and Open/All-Star teams are eligible.

Playing Sites: Playing sites may be added or dropped as necessary. We will do our best to limit travel as much as possible.

Grades 3-8: Teams will be placed at one of the sites listed below

Grades 9-12: See Entry Form for specific sites on each play date

Playing Sites: Armstrong HS, Blaine HS, Champlin Park HS, Concordia U. (St Paul), Coon Rapids HS, Henry Sibley HS, Hopkins HS, Park Center HS, Prior Lake HS, Shakopee HS, Spring Lake Park HS

Player Eligibility: Players must play in the grade in which they are enrolled. They may play up a grade division, but not down. Boys must play on boys' teams and girls must play on girls' teams.

Roster Info: Teams are required to complete the official MYAS Online Roster.

1. **Login-** Go to myas.org and click on the login button.
2. **Find your team.** Or if you haven't added your team yet, click on "New Team" and add your team name and coach's information.
3. **Add Players and Coaches-** You can now add players to your roster. Please be sure to click Save after you submit the information for each player. Please be aware that name, address, email, phone and date of birth are all required fields. For the birth date, click on the calendar button. Then, click on the month and year at the top of the calendar. Then, click on the year. You can then click directly into the year that the player was born.
4. **Print it-** Once your roster is complete, you will need to print it. Click on the Roster Print button located at the top of the page.
5. **Signatures-** On the printed copy, you will notice signature bars next to each player and coach. That is where the coaches and player's parents can sign agreeing to the MYAS Code of Conduct policy and the MYAS Waiver statement.
6. **Submit it-** Bring the roster to your first MYAS Spring Tournament and give it to the tournament director during [team check-in](#). Once you have submitted the roster at your first tournament, you do not need to submit it at your following tournaments unless you have changes to your roster. If you have changes to your roster, it is your responsibility to provide the tournament director with an updated copy at the beginning of the tournament.

Coaching Note: If you plan on coaching multiple teams, the MYAS does ***not*** guarantee that they will be placed at the same playing site or that the schedules will allow you to coach both teams. We highly recommend coaching only one team.

- Schedules:** Schedules will be available on our website (www.myas.org) 10 days before the event.
- Admission:** An admission fee will be charged (\$7 per adult and \$5 per student/senior citizen). All players and up to three coaches per team will be admitted free of charge.
- Awards:** Teams placing high enough at the Fall Championships will receive awards. Awards are not given at the other play dates.
- Refund Policy:** **NO** refunds or transfers will be issued after the entry deadline.
- Forfeit Policy:** Forfeiting a game in any MYAS fall basketball event will place your team on probation and a \$200 fine will be assessed. This fine **MUST** be submitted to the on-site coordinator or the MYAS office prior to your next scheduled game. Forfeiting a second game will automatically **SUSPEND** your team (including all coaches and rostered players) for the remainder of the league and from any subsequent MYAS events for a period of one calendar year. There will be an additional \$100 fine for EACH forfeit. **GET TO YOUR GAMES!**

MYAS COACH AND PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1) I will not berate the officials or “trash talk” my opponent.
- 2) I will not use profanity.
- 3) I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, contest administrators and officials at every game.
- 4) I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my teammates and opponents ahead of my personal desire to win.
- 5) I will treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, gender, creed or ability.
- 6) I will demand a sports environment that is free from drugs, tobacco and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all MYAS sporting events.
- 7) I will do my best to remember that youth sports are supposed to be FUN and that winning and losing are part of everyone’s experience.
- 8) I will express my concerns through the proper channels in a dignified manner.
- 9) I will respect the volunteers who are assisting with the conduct of MYAS events.
- 10) I will respect and adhere to the rules governing eligibility and competition.

PENALTY

Any violation of the MYAS Code of Conduct may result in temporary or permanent banishment from any MYAS sponsored events.
