

# 2017 MYAS Winter Jamboree

## Playing Rules and Format

Except where modified, National Federation of State High School Associations rules will govern play.

**Timing:** Two 15-minute running time periods.  
5-minute warm up (Subject to change)  
5-minute half-time (Subject to change)

**Time Outs:** Each team is awarded one 1-minute time out per game.

**3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Rule:**

- May not play full court defense
- May not play zone defense

**Fouls/Free Throws:** Individual and team fouls will not be recorded. Free throws will be awarded on shooting fouls. On non-shooting fouls, the ball will be awarded out of bounds. For technical fouls, two points will be awarded to the offended team and they will also get the ball.

**Scorekeeping:** The host will operate the clock and scoreboard.  
Team and player fouls will not be recorded.

**Team Composition:** Teams must be formed by a bona fide traveling basketball association or school. No All-Star or renegade teams will be knowingly permitted to play.

**Uniforms:** Jersey tops must be of similar color and it is recommended that they are numbered on the front and back. It is recommended that numbers be at least four inches high and be any combination of 0 or 00, 1-5, 10-15, 20-25, 30-35, 40-45 and 50-55. Teams should always bring their light and dark colored jerseys.

**Basketballs:** The 3rd-6th grade boys' teams and all girls' teams will use the women's size (28.5) basketball, and 7th & 8th grade boys' teams will use the official men's size basketball. The referee will select the best ball available for each game.

**First Aid:** Each team is required to provide their own first aid supplies, water bottles, tape, etc. The host is required to provide an on-site trainer.

**Conduct:** Unsportsmanlike conduct by players, coaches, parents or fans will not be tolerated and will be penalized accordingly.

**Awards:** Awards will not presented for this event.
