This is my first time registering for the Midwest Regional meet. How do I register?

What if a swimmer records a new time after I have already sent in the HY-Tek file?

Updates will be allowed up to the entry deadline. Please resend the entire team's file. We will not accept any updates after the deadline – no exceptions!

What is the determining age for a swimmer at the Midwest Regional Swim Meet?

December 1, 2017 is the age determining date when registering for events.

Why are swimmers only allowed to swim one relay per day at Midwest Regionals?

This rule is in place to prevent swimmers from racking up individual and team points.

Does a coach need to be in attendance for the 2018 Midwest Regional Swim Meet?

There is no requirement that any swimmer needs a coach present in order to participate.

Once entries are submitted, how long will it take to know if the swimmer is "accepted"?

If we have to place caps on events, we would notify you immediately after the deadline. We will accept all entries up to 1,300 swimmers. If more than 1,300 swimmers sign up, we will use the event caps starting with the longest events, to reach the 1,300 swimmer mark.

Can a swimmer from another club/team swim on our relay team?

Is the Midwest Regional Swim Meet sanctioned or approved by USA Swimming? Will swimmers' times be recognized by USA Swimming?

The Midwest Regional Swim Meet is USA Swimming approved. As a result, the swimmers' times will be recognized by USA Swimming.

Do swimmers' times have to come from a USA or YMCA sanctioned meet?

No, times do not have to come from a USA or YMCA sanctioned event. The times simply have to result from a swim meet with certified officials.
