

2018 MYAS Winter Jamboree

Playing Rules and Format

Except where modified, National Federation of State High School Associations rules will govern play.

Team Composition: Teams must be formed by a bona fide traveling basketball association or school. No all-Star or renegade teams will be knowingly permitted to play.

Timing: Two 15-minute running time periods.
5-minute warm up (Subject to change)
5-minute half-time (Subject to change)

Time Outs: Each team is awarded one 1-minute time out per game.

Pressing: 3rd and 4th grade teams may not play full court defense
3rd and 4th grade teams may not play zone defenses

First offense – a warning will be issued; second offense – technical foul.

Fouls/Free Throws: Individual and team fouls will not be recorded. Free throws will be awarded on shooting fouls. On non-shooting fouls, the ball will be awarded out of bounds. For technical fouls, two points will be awarded to the offended team and they will also get the ball.

Uniforms: Jersey tops must be of similar color and it is recommended that they are numbered on the front **and** back. It is recommended that numbers be at least four inches high and be any combination of 0 or 00, 1-5, 10-15, 20-25, 30-35, 40-45 and 50-55. Teams should always bring their light **and** dark colored jerseys.

Basketballs: The 3rd-6th grade boys' teams and all girls' teams will use the women's size (28.5) basketball, and 7th & 8th grade boys' teams will use the official men's size basketball.

Ejection Policy: Any player, coach or spectator who has been ejected from a contest is declared to be ineligible for the remainder of that contest **AND** the next scheduled contest. Any player, coach or spectator ejected for **flagrant unsportsmanlike conduct** will be ejected for the remainder of the entire competition and may be subject to additional disciplinary action(s). Some examples of "flagrant unsportsmanlike conduct" include, but are not limited to fighting, repeated verbal abuse, intentional actions that inflict or intend to inflict bodily harm, cheating (such as use of a declared ineligible player or coach), repeated use of profane language. Any person ejected from a contest must leave the vicinity (**out of sight and sound**) of the playing area immediately and is prohibited from any further contact (**direct or indirect**) with the team until such time that the suspension has been lifted. Failure to comply with the rules of ejection may result in **game forfeiture**.

First Aid: Teams are responsible for their own first aid supplies, water bottles, tape, etc.

Awards: Awards will not be presented for this event.
