

2022 MYAS Winter Jamboree

Except where modified, National Federation of State High School Associations rules will govern play.

Team Composition: Teams must be formed by a bona fide traveling basketball association or school. No open/all-Star or independent teams will be knowingly permitted to play.

Timing: Two 20-minute running time halves
Stop time – last two minutes of each half
5-minute warm up (Subject to change)
5-minute half-time (Subject to change)

Time Outs: Each team is awarded one 1-minute time out per game.

Defense Restrictions and Free Throw Distances:

<u>Grades</u>	<u>Half-Court Defense</u>	<u>Full-Court Defense</u>	<u>Free Throws</u>
3-4	Person-to-Person Only	Not Allowed	12 Feet
5	Person-to-Person Only	Person-to-Person Only	15 Feet
6-8	No Restrictions	No Restrictions	15 Feet

Penalty: After the first warning, the penalty for each violation of this rule will be a technical foul.

Exception: No teams may use a full-court press if they are ahead of their opponent by +20 points

Fouls/Free Throws

- Individual and team fouls will not be recorded.
- Free throws will be awarded on shooting fouls.
- On non-shooting fouls, the offended team will be awarded one point and get the ball out of bounds.
- For technical fouls, two points will be awarded to the offended team, and they will also get the ball.

Basketballs

- 27.5 boys' and girls' grades 3 & 4
- 28.5 boys' grades 5 & 6 and girls' grades 5-8
- 29.5 boys' grades 7 & 8

Uniforms:

Jersey tops must be of similar color, and it is recommended that they are numbered on the front **and** back. It recommended that numbers be at least four inches high and be any combination of 0 or 00, 1-5, 10-15, 20-25, 30-35, 40-45 and 50-55. Teams should always bring their light **and** dark colored jerseys.

Ejection Policy:

Any player, coach or spectator ejected from a game is declared ineligible for the remainder of that game **AND** the next one. Any player, coach or spectator ejected for **flagrant unsportsmanlike conduct** will be ejected for the remainder of the entire competition and may be subject to additional disciplinary action(s). Examples are "flagrant unsportsmanlike conduct" include, but are not limited to fighting, repeated verbal abuse, intentional actions that inflict or intend to inflict bodily harm, cheating, repeated use of profane language. Any person ejected from a contest must leave the vicinity of the playing area immediately and is prohibited from any further contact (direct or indirect) with the team until the suspension has been lifted. Failure to comply with the rules of ejection may result in **game forfeiture**.

Awards: Awards will not be presented for this event.
